First Generation

1. **Timothy or Michael HANLEY (caution: not verified)** was born (date unknown). We are not sure if the above was Timothy or Michael - or even someone else. Perhaps it is most likely that he was Timothy, who married Mary Cormack (or McCormack), as I have been DNA-matched with a descendant of Johanna (Julia), one of their children, indicating a close connection between my great-great-grandmother Mary Hanley and Timothy and Mary. However, my great-grandmother might have have been a niece of Timothy's rather than a daughter. Julia (1830-1916) married Leonard Fitzgerald and lived in Moanvanun, Cappawhite, Co. Tipperary.

Another possility is that 'unknown' above was Michael who was married to Ellen Lonergan. I have been DNA-matched by Ancestry with descendants of some of their children, suggesting that my great-great-grandmother was a child of theirs. However, Mary may equally have been a stepdaughter of Ellen's (Michael married twice) or a niece of Michael's, so we cannot say for certain that Michael was Mary's father or Ellen her mother. The most likely scenario, in my opinion, is that Michael and the aforementioned Timothy were brothers and my great-great-grandmother was a daughter of one of them.

A descendant of Michael's has told me that probably between 1830 and 1843 Michael and his family were evicted from their farm in Soloheadbeg and moved to Cooga in the parish of Doon, Co. Limerick. Family lore has it that the old Hanley farm was on Lord Stanley's estate and could be seen from the the big house, as a result of which the lord wished to be rid of the tenants, hence the eviction. It is possible that they were offered alternative land in Cooga by the lord because in Griffith's Valuation (1850s), Lord Stanley is shown to be their landlord in Cooga. Descendants of this Hanley family apparently still live in Cooga.

Michael's children were Julia (born 1815), Ellen (born 1818) who married Patrick Tobin in Doon in 1843 and John Lloyd in 1853 (there was a son named Richard from the second marriage who lived in Christchurch, New Zealand), Timothy (died before 12 February 1866), John (born 1824), Michael (1825-1860) and possibly my great-great-grandmother Mary (born around 1826). I have been DNA-matched to a descendant of Timothy's daughter Ellen, who was baptised in Solohead on 26 April 1846 and died in 1915. She married William Grogan (c.1838-1914) of Ashgrove, Bansha, Co. Tipperary. They had three sons, John (Jack), Charles and Timothy, all born in Ashgrove. Timothy (1873-1930) married Hannah Kirk, with whom he had a son, also named Timothy, who was born in Dublin in 1919 and died in Huddersfield in 2000. The younger Timothy and his wife, Alice, raised a family in Huddersfield. I have also been DNA-matched to a descendant of Michael's son Michael (i.e. the child born in 1825), who married Johanna Sheehy from Doon, Co. Limerick in 1851. Their first child, Michael, was born in Doon before the family emigrated to Australia, where four more children were born in NSW: Johanna, Bridget, Richard and John.

I have also had contact with Michael H. Ryan who is a descendant of Thomas Ryan (believed to have been from Soloheadbeg) and Julia Hanley who married in Solohead/Oola on 21 January 1854. Could Julia have been related to our Hanleys? In case there is a connection, here are some details on the children of Thomas and Julia Ryan:

Thomas, born 1855, probably in Soloheadbeg
Thady (also known as Timothy), baptised 30 July 1856 in Tipperary (ancestor of Michael H. Ryan)
Bridget, baptised 8 December 1857 (although Michael also has a baptismal date of 18 February 1857 for possibly the same person - could the first Bridget have died?)
Richard (although no documentation has been located for him)

Details of another Hanley family from Soloheadbeg come from Seamus Carrabine whose great-great-grandfather Patrick Hanley was born in Lisobohane, Solohead about 1842. Patrick, who may have had a brother named William, married Hanora English and they had 10 children, one of whom died in childhood. Seamus's great-grandfather, James, who was the seventh of the 10, was born in Soloheadbeg on 19 June 1878. All nine children who survived to adulthood emigrated to the United States and three, Timothy, Patrick and Edmond, joined the NYPD. It is believed that Edmond eventually became Deputy Chief of the NYPD.

Information on yet another Hanley family with Solohead connections comes from Marguerite Hanley, whose husband's great-great-grandfather, Edmond Hanley, was born in 1825 in the parish of Solohead and Oola. Edmond's parents were Edmond Hanley and Mary Fox and his siblings were John (born 1818), Ellen (1819), William (1822) and possibly a Mary and Anne. Edmond Junior married Mary Mulcahy from Murroe, Co. Limerick in 1855 and their children were Martin (Marguerite's husband's great-grandfather), Patrick, Edmond, Bridget and Mary. Martin married Annie Connell in 1886 and their children were Mary Josephine, Patrick, Edmond, Annie, Bridget, Honora, Johanna, John (Margurite's husband's grandfather), Peter, James and Martin.

And another Hanley family: A John Hanley was baptised in 1836 in Solohead to a John Hanley and a Margaret Dwyer whose parents were Jeremiah Dwyer and Mary Ryan. The younger John emigrated to Australia where in 1862 he married Alice Dwyer who was born in Clonulty, Australia in 1841. John and Alice lived in Tatura, Victoria and later in Leongatha, Victoria, and had a son named Patrick. Many of John and Alice's descendants still live in the Leongatha area.

And in case it may relate to our Hanley family here is the text of an obituary from a Chicago newspaper that was passed on to me:

Barnes, Catherine, nee Hanley, June 3, 1888, aged 60 yrs., native of Sologhead (Parish Solloghodbeg), Co. Tipperary. Funeral from resid., 623 W. Erie St. to St. Columbkille's Church to Calvary.

Note: The Hanley surname is numerous throughout Ireland, especially in north Munster and in Connacht. The Hanleys were originally a sept of Co. Roscommon. The Irish form of the name is "Ó h-Áinle" from the Irish word "áinle" meaning "beauty". Timothy or Michael HANLEY (caution: not verified) was married.

Timothy or Michael HANLEY had the following child:

+2 i Mary HANLEY, born abt 1826, probably Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary; married Edmond (Ned) CAREW, 20 Feb 1849, Solohead, Co. Tipperary; died 6 Apr 1899, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary.

Second Generation

2. Mary HANLEY (Timothy or Michael-1) was born about 1826 in probably Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. She died on 6 Apr 1899 at the age of 73 in Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. In August 1873 Mary was shot at by Denis Treacy, the brother of Thomas Treacy who was the husband of Mary's daughter Mary. She escaped injury. At the time, Denis and Thomas were engaged in a bitter dispute over ownership of the family farm which led to a series of violent incidents. Mary HANLEY and Edmond (Ned) CAREW were married on 20 Feb 1849 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. Witnesses to the marriage were Thomas Carey and William Carey.

Edmond (Ned) CAREW, son of Edmond CAREW and Mary GAVIN, was born about 18 Feb 1820 in Soloheadbeg area, Co. Tipperary. He was christened on 18 Feb 1820 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. He died on 17 Nov 1897 at the age of 77 in Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. Ned was Patrick's twin. Ned's baptismal sponsor was Catherine Flinn (no other sponsor listed).

It appears that all of Ned's siblings who reached adulthood emigrated, most if not all going to Newfoundland, Canada. Thomas Suttles, a Carew/Gavin descendant, has kindly sent me a transcription of an interesting letter written in 1878 by John, one of Ned's brothers, to their sister Nancy. John was living in Newfoundland and Nancy was living in the United States. In the letter, John mentions the death of his mother, Mary, in Newfoundland in 1863; reference is also made to a sister, Johanna, also in Newfoundland, a brother, Michael (whereabouts unknown), and the widow of another brother, Thomas, who was living on Prince Edward Island. John also mentions a relative who "was some time ago in Ireland and went to see brother Edward", supporting the theory that Edmond (the name Edmond is interchangeable with Edward) was the only sibling to have remained in Ireland.

Although Ned appears to have used the Carew surname, some of his children went by the name of Carey. The two names appear to have been interchangeable in Tipperary at that time.

There was bad feeling between Ned and a Denis Treacy, also of Soloheadbeg. Denis was the brother of Ned's daughter Mary's husband, Thomas Treacy. The tension between Ned and Denis was likely due to Ned's connection to Thomas who was involved in a bitter legal dispute with Denis in the late 1860s and early 1870s over their mother's will. In August 1873 Denis fired at shot at Ned's wife, Mary, but she escaped unhurt. Then, two months later, Ned's daughter Mary (Treacy) was seriously injured from a kicking by him while pregnant with her first child. Further violence ensued in July 1874 when Mary's sister-in-law Johanna Hayes (née Treacy) was murdered in her home in Soloheadbeg. Because Johanna and her husband had taken Denis's side in the dispute over the will, suspicion fell on Ned, his son Edmond and son-in-law Thomas (Treacy), who were all were taken into custody. All three were later released as no evidence could be found to prove they were involved. The murder was never solved.

According to his death record, Ned died at the age of 80 of "probably decline of life".

In case there is a connection with Ned's family, a direct descendant of a Thomas D'Arcy with Solohead connections has told me that there is a headstone in Solohead graveyard, believed to be Thomas's, with the name of Thomas's wife, Catherine Carew, also engraved on it. Thomas was born about 1814 and died in 1877 aged 63. Could Catherine have been related to Ned?

Edmond (Ned) CAREW and Mary HANLEY had the following children:

+3 i Edmond CAREW/CAREY, born abt 9 Jul 1849, possibly Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co.

- Tipperary; married Mary Ann PRIEST, 1886, Sydney; died 1 Aug 1924, Alexandria, New South Wales.
- +4 ii Mary CAREY, born abt 29 Apr 1851, possibly Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary; married Thomas TREACY, 25 Feb 1873, Solohead, Co. Tipperary; died 30 Sep 1929, County Hospital, Fermoy, Co. Cork.
- +5 iii **Catherine (Kate) CAREW**, born abt 18 Feb 1853, possibly Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary; married Jeremiah HAMS, 11 Dec 1880, Sydney; married William KANE, abt 1911, Marrickville, New South Wales; died 1934, New South Wales.
- 6 iv **Timothy CAREW** was born about 30 Jan 1855 in possibly Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. He was christened on 30 Jan 1855 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. He died possibly 10 Aug 1929 at the age of 74 in New South Wales. Sponsors at Timothy's baptism were Edmond Godfrey and Julia Hanley.
 - Timothy may have emigrated to Australia and may be the Timothy Carew from Paddington, New South Wales, a carter, who died aged 74 on 10 August 1929 and is buried in Rookwood Cemetery, Sydney.
- +7 v **Michael CAREW (caution: not verified)**, born Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary; married Margaret (Maggie) O'NEILL; died Australia.
- +8 vi **Johanna Mary CAREW/CAREY**, born abt 17 Feb 1857, possibly Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary; married James Michael MURPHY, 2 May 1887, Solohead Chapel, Co. Tipperary; died aft 1 Jun 1911, probably Hamilton, Ontario.

- +10 viii **Sarah Agnes (Agnes) CAREW**, born abt 22 Dec 1863, possibly Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary; married Patrick MONAHAN, 27 Nov 1884, Tipperary Chapel, Co. Tipperary; died 3 Apr 1935, Duncannon, Co. Wexford.
- +11 ix **John Joseph CAREW**, born abt 21 Oct 1866, Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary; married Ann (Annie) KELLY, 20 Apr 1909, Hamilton, Ontario; died 12 Jun 1935, Wentworth, Ontario.
- +12 x **Bridget CAREW**, born abt 27 Aug 1869, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary; married John O'DWYER; died 1941, proabably Co. Tipperary.

Third Generation

3. **Edmond CAREW/CAREY** (Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born about 9 Jul 1849 in possibly Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. He was christened on 9 Jul 1849 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. He died on 1 Aug 1924 at the age of 75 in Alexandria, New South Wales. Sponsors at Edmond's baptism were William Carey and Mary Carey. Edmund's surname appears as "Keary' in the baptismal register and Edmond himself went by the name of Carey.

In late 1874 Edmond was taken into custody following the murder of his sister Mary Treacy's sister-in-law Johanna Hayes. Mary's husband, Thomas Treacy, and his brother Denis were involved in a bitter legal battle in the late 1860s and early 1870s over their mother's will. Thomas and Denis's sister Johanna took Denis's side in the dispute When Johanna was shot dead in her home in Milltown, Soloheadmore, Co. Tipperary in October 1874, Edmond, his father (Ned) and brother-in-law Thomas were brought in for questioning but all three were later released. Edmond had presumably come under suspicion as his mother had previously been shot at by Denis, and on a later occasion his sister Mary (i.e. Thomas's wife) was physically attacked by Denis. The murder was never solved.

Edmond later emigrated to Australia (sometime between 1874 and 1886). Edmond CAREW/CAREY and Mary Ann PRIEST were married in 1886 in Sydney.

Mary Ann PRIEST, daughter of Thomas PRIEST and Ann TIERNEY, was born about 1863. I have been told Mary died in 1886 (in Sydney) but it seems this is not correct she had children born after this date.

Edmond CAREW/CAREY and Mary Ann PRIEST had the following children:

- i **Daniel CAREY** was born in 1886 in New South Wales. He died on 1 Aug 1886 at the age of 0 in Petersham, New South Wales. Daniel died in infancy.
- +14 ii **Mary Ann CAREY**, born 1887, Alexandria, New South Wales; married James F. REILLY; died 1970, Sydney.
- +15 iii **Elizabeth (Liz) Ellen CAREY**, born 1889, Sydney; married Joseph Patrick MCCARTHY/KELLY, 1921, Sydney; died 1963.
- iv **Edmund J. CAREY** was born in 1891 in Sydney.
- +17 v Martha Ethel CAREY, born Sydney; married 'unknown' O'KEEFFE.
- vi **John (Jack) CAREY** was born in Sydney.
- 4. Mary CAREY (Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born about 29 Apr 1851 in possibly Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. She was christened on 29 Apr 1851 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. She died on 30 Sep 1929 at the age of 78 in County Hospital, Fermoy, Co. Cork. Sponsors at Mary's baptism were Michael Carey and Margaret Hanley. Mary's surname appears as "Keary' in the baptism register.

Mary was about 30 years younger than her husband, Thomas. Thomas and his brother Denis were involved in a lengthy and bitter dispute in the late 1860s and early 1870s over their mother's will. The battle for the family farm led to violence, including an attack on Mary by Denis in October 1873 while she was pregnant. He received a prison sentence for the crime.

At the time of the 1911 census, Mary, by then widowed, was living with her son Martin in Carrick-on-Suir, Co. Tipperary where Martin was working as manager of the gasworks. When he was appointed manager of the

gasworks in Wicklow town and later Fermoy, Co. Cork Mary seems to have gone with him as an extract from the 1851 census dated 31 March 1920 (the census was probably checked to verify Mary's pension eligibility) gives her address in 1920 as "c/o M. J. Treacy, Gasworks, Fermoy". Mary CAREY and Thomas TREACY were married on 25 Feb 1873 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. Witnesses to the marriage of Thomas and Mary were Edmond Hanley and Catherine Carew.

Thomas TREACY, son of John TREACY and Mary LOOBY, was born about 8 Nov 1821 in Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. He was christened on 8 Nov 1821 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. He died on 24 Dec 1895 at the age of 74 in Murgasty, Co. Tipperary. Thomas's baptismal sponsors were John Hanley and Winifred Connors.

Interestingly, among all the sponsors at the baptisms of the children of Thomas and his wife, Mary, there is not a single Treacy; the sponsors are mostly Carews. The reason for this is probably the dispute that had arisen between Thomas and his only surviving brother, Denis, over their mother's will. See the notes below for Denis for further details of the case which culminated in Denis's inheritance of the farm and Thomas's eviction. Thomas and his family ended up moving to Tipperary town, (probably in 1875) where Thomas found work as a labourer initially. By the time of the birth of his son Edmund in 1875 he was a shopkeeper, and at the time of the birth of his son Thomas in 1881 he was the superintendant of a coal yard. At the time of his death aged 74 in 1895 he was a labourer. Thomas died of 'Cystitis (3-4 months)" and "Asthenia".

Thomas TREACY and Mary CAREY had the following children:

- i **John TREACY** was born on 4 Dec 1873 in Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. He was christened on 5 Dec 1873 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. He died between Mar 1874 and 1 Nov 1874 at the age of 0 in Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. Sponsors at John's baptism were Michael Looby and Catherine Carey. While John's mother was pregnant with him, she received a savage kicking from her brother-in-law Denis Treacy who was engaged in a bitter legal dispute with John's father. However there is no evidence to suggest a link between the attack and John's early death.
- ii **John TREACY** was born about 30 Oct 1874 in Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. He was christened on 30 Oct 1874 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. Sponsors at John's baptism were Michael Looby and Catherine Carey. According to an article on the Treacys of Soloheadbeg by Denis G. Marnane in the Tipperary Historical Journal of 2010, John above died in infancy.
- 21 iii **Edmund TREACY** was born on 6 Nov 1875 in Meeting St., Tipperary, Co. Tipperary. He was christened on 8 Nov 1875 in Tipperary, Co. Tipperary. He died probably Apr 1906 at the age of 30 in probably San Francisco. Sponsors at Edmund's baptism were Edmund Carey and Margaret O'Dwyer.

Edmund emigrated to the United States as a young man. Ellis Island records were checked but nothing that definitely related to this Edmund was found.

I am told that Edmund probably died in the San Francisco earthquake of 1906 as he was living there at the time and nothing more was heard from him after the event. However, we have no documented evidence to prove this. Note that the Edmund Treacy who died in California on 7 October 1911, and who had brothers named John and Timothy, and who is buried in Holy Cross Cemetery in San Mateo, California, is NOT our Edmund. Treacy researchers may be interested to know that John, Timothy and Edmund were born in Co. Limerick in the 1850s/1860s and Timothy became a State Senator.

iv **Timothy (Timmy) Joseph TREACY** was born about 16 Jul 1878 in Church St., Tipperary. He was christened on 16 Jul 1878 in Tipperary. He died on 28 Nov 1930 at the age of 52 in

Lisnabrinnia, Mountnugent, Co. Cavan. Timothy was buried on 30 Nov 1930 in Ballinacree Cemetery, Mountnugent, Co. Cavan. Sponsors at Timmy's baptism were were John Casey and Johanna Casey (should "Casey" read "Carey"?).

It appears Timmy became a Christian Brother as there is a 22-year-old Co. Tipperary-born brother named Timothy Treacy listed in the 1901 census with three other brothers at Railway Road, Bagenalstown, Co. Carlow. All four are teachers. It seems Timmy had moved to London by 1911. No record could be located for him in the Irish census of that year but in the 1911 UK census there is a 31-year-old Tipperary-born school teacher named Timothy Joseph Treacy (although our Timmy would have been 32 years of age at the time) listed as a boarder in the household of a Mr. John McGuinness and his Tipperary-born wife, Bridget, of 9 St. Kilda Road in West Ealing.

Timmy did not remain a Christian Brother for very long as he appears to have been living in Co. Wicklow in 1918 as a layman. Notes from The Anglo-Celt newspaper mention that "Mr. T.J. Treacy", who had been giving woodworking courses in Co. Cavan, had sent a letter to the Cavan Technical Committee, "dated from Wicklow, where Mr. Treacy lived", stating that he was unable to attend a committee meeting on 13 July 1918 owing to a bout of influenza. Timmy's brother Martin was working in Wicklow at this time and it is possible that Timmy was living with Martin. Martin moved to Fermoy. Co. Cork in 1919 but we do not know if Timmy remained in Wicklow after that or moved permanently to Co. Cavan.

Later editions of The Anglo Celt tell us that Timmy continued giving woodworking courses in Co. Cavan until 1929, with classes in Belturbet in 1918 and 1919, Shercock in 1920, Cootehill in 1921, Ballinagh and Bunnoe in 1926 and Maghera in 1929. However, on 6 November 1929, he left a course he was teaching in Mountnugent and was put on sick leave. Timmy was suffering from depression and had been expected to return to work a year later when, sadly, on 28 November 1930, he took his own life. He had used a gun belonging to the owner of the Lisnabrinnia lodging house where he had been living for about a year and where the incident took place. According to the inquest report, Timmy had not been in good health for many months and had been spending a lot of time in bed. A Dr. Cassidy told the inquest "I have been attending deceased for the past twelve months. On my first visit I found he was suffering from influenza and subsequent to this he developed neurasthenia¹; I strongly advised him to go into a nursing home, but he refused". Later in his deposition Dr. Cassidy said "The reason why I urged deceased to go to a nursing home was that I dreaded he might do himself an injury".

Full details of the inquest (which incorrectly states that Timmy was a native of Wicklow) can be found on pages 1 and 3 of The Anglo-Celt of 6 December 1930.

- 1. A term, no longer used, describing 'nervous exhaustion' with sufferers displaying both psychological and physical symptoms such as fatigue, neuralgia, anxiety, dizziness and depression. 'Bed rest cure' in a hospital was usually prescribed.

5. **Catherine (Kate) CAREW** (Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born about 18 Feb 1853 in possibly Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. She was christened on 18 Feb 1853 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. She died in 1934 at the age of 81 in New South Wales. Sponsors at Kate's baptism were John Hanley and Maria Hanley.

Kate emigrated to Australia. Catherine (Kate) CAREW and Jeremiah HAMS were married on 11 Dec 1880 in Sydney.

Jeremiah HAMS was born in 1848 in Wiltshire, England. He died in 1889 at the age of 41 in New South Wales. Jeremiah died at the age 40 of tuberculosis.

Jeremiah HAMS and Catherine (Kate) CAREW had the following child:

+25 i **Archibald Augustus HAMS**, born 1885; married Elizabeth Maria MCINTYRE; died 1960.

Catherine (Kate) CAREW and William KANE were married about 1911 in Marrickville, New South Wales.

William KANE was born (date unknown).

7. **Michael CAREW (caution: not verified)** (Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born in Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. He died in Australia. I have been told that Edmond and Mary had a son named Michael who emigrated to Australia and married a Maggie O'Brien. However I have come across no evidence to support this so I have added a caution beside his name. Michael CAREW (caution: not verified) and Margaret (Maggie) O'NEILL were married.

Margaret (Maggie) O'NEILL was born (date unknown).

8. **Johanna Mary CAREW/CAREY** (Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born about 17 Feb 1857 in possibly Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. She was christened on 17 Feb 1857 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. She died after 1 Jun 1911 at the age of 54 in probably Hamilton, Ontario. Sponsors at Johanna's baptism were Cornelius Hanley and Sarah Hanley.

Johanna's age on her marriage certificate is 25 although she would have been 30 years old at the time. Similarly, the 1901 Canadian census gives Johanna's date of birth as 17 March 1863, about five years later than her actual date of birth. It is possible of course that the Johanna born in February 1857 died as a child and another daughter, named Johanna, was born in March 1863.

Johanna and her husband, James, emigrated to Canada in 1887 (this information comes from the 1911 Canadian census), settling in Hamilton, Ontario. Johanna Mary CAREW/CAREY and James Michael MURPHY were married on 2 May 1887 in Solohead Chapel, Co. Tipperary. Witnesses to the marriage were John Carey (sic) and Bridget Carey (sic), presumably Johanna's youngest brother and sister. The Carew and Carey surnames were interchangeable in south Tipperary at the time.

James Michael MURPHY, son of Thomas MURPHY, was born about 1851 in Ireland. He died on 3 Aug 1906 at the age of 55 in Hamilton, Ontario. We do not know where exactly James was born but his address at the time of his marriage, in May 1887, was Clonmeen, Co. Tipperary and he was a policeman. However, following his emigration to Canada later that year, he worked initially as a labourer and later as a porter.

James's marriage record tells us he was 35 years of age when he married (i.e. born about 1851). However the 1901 census of Canada tells us he was born on 10 August 1860.

James Michael MURPHY and Johanna Mary CAREW/CAREY had the following children:

- 9. **Daniel CAREW** (Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born about 1 Apr 1859 in Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. He was christened on 1 Apr 1859 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. He died on 30 Nov 1930 at the age of 71 in Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. Sponsors at Daniel's baptism were Daniel Hanley and Honora Godfrey. The family's address on the baptism record is given as Newtown. Presumably this is the townland of Newtown in the parish of Soloheadbeg, and Daniel's birthplace.

According to the 1911 census, Daniel was a farmer and farrier (blacksmith). He and his wife and children are the only Carew family listed in Soloheadbeg. Assuming he inherited the family farm, it is probable that his elder brothers, Edmund and Timothy, had died or emigrated. Daniel CAREW and Mary COFFEY were married on 1 Mar 1897 in Solohead Chapel, Co. Tipperary. Witnesses were John Treacy and Julia Mahoney.

Mary COFFEY, daughter of William COFFEY, was born about 1862 in probably Gortanerrig, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. She died on 17 Aug 1933 at the age of 71 in Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. According to the 1911 census, Daniel and Mary had four children born alive, three of whom were alive in 1911.

Mary died of stomach cancer.

Daniel CAREW and Mary COFFEY had the following children:

10. **Sarah Agnes (Agnes) CAREW** (Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born about 22 Dec 1863 in possibly Newtown, Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. She was christened on 22 Dec 1863 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. She died on 3 Apr 1935 at the age of 71 in Duncannon, Co. Wexford. Sponsors at Agnes's baptism were Joan Ryan and Catherine Ryan.

According to the 1911 census, Agnes and her husband, Patrick, had been married 26 years and had seven children born alive, all of whom were alive at the time of the census. Sarah Agnes (Agnes) CAREW and Patrick MONAHAN were married on 27 Nov 1884 in Tipperary Chapel, Co. Tipperary. Witnesses were Martin J. O'Donnell and Joanna M. Carew.

Patrick MONAHAN, son of Patrick MONAHAN and Catherine LARNER, was born about 1853 in east Co. Galway. He died on 9 May 1915 at the age of 62 in Duncannon, Co. Wexford. Patrick was a member of the RIC (Royal Irish Constabulary). RIC records show that a Patrick Monahan, born in Co. Galway, enlisted in the force in 1874 aged 21. I think it likely that this relates to our Patrick. At the time of his marriage, in 1884, Patrick was an RIC constable in Golden, Co. Tipperary. The 1901 census tells us he was still a policeman 17 years later and living in Duncannon, Co. Wexford, but by the time of the birth of his youngest child, Harriet, in 1902 he had become a shopkeeper in Duncannon. In the 1911 census he is described as a shopkeeper and publican. His father had also been a shopkeeper.

Patrick MONAHAN and Sarah Agnes (Agnes) CAREW had the following children:

- i William Joseph MONAHAN was born on 13 Jun 1886 in Co. Tipperary. He died on 24 Nov 1918 at the age of 32 in Co. Tipperary. From family sources I have William's birth and death dates, as well as counties of birth and death. However, I have been unable to confirm any of this information. Nor can I find any trace of William in the 1911 census. He is listed in the 1901 census, when he was aged 14 and living with his family in Duncannon, Co. Wexford. In case he emigrated I checked immigration records on the Ancestry website but nothing was found.

He died on 12 Jun 1935 at the age of 68 in Wentworth, Ontario. John was buried in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery, Hamilton, Ontario. Sponsors at John's baptism were Anthony Ryan and Margaret Godfrey. The family's address on the baptism

record is given as Newtown. Presumably this is the townland of Newtown in the parish of Soloheadbeg, and John's birthplace.

John emigrated to Canada in 1888 (according to the 1911 census of Canada) or 1891 (according to the 1921 census). He lived in Hamilton, Ontario where he worked as a mechanic (according to his marriage certificate), iron worker (from his daughter's birth certificate), plumber (from the 1921 census) and fireman for an underground cable company (according to his death certificate).

John died from a "cerebral hemorrhage and oedema" due to "toxic degeneration [of] viscera, acute alcoholic intoxication, chronic myocarditis, chronic nephritis". John Joseph CAREW and Ann (Annie) KELLY were married on 20 Apr 1909 in Hamilton, Ontario.

Ann (Annie) KELLY, daughter of Patrick KELLY and Honora O'ROURKE, was born about 1866 in Hamilton, Ontario. Annie was a tailoress, according to her marriage certificate.

John Joseph CAREW and Ann (Annie) KELLY had the following child:

- i Mary Leocadia CAREW was born on 6 May 1910 in 236 Catharine St. North, Hamilton, Ontario. She died on 11 Apr 1944 at the age of 33 in Hamilton, Ontario. She was buried in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery, Hamilton, Ontario. Mary worked as a clerk for an insurance company. She suffered from multiple sclerosis and died from the condition at the age of 33. She was unmarried. At the time of her death Mary's home address, where she lived with her mother, was 6 Holton Avenue South in Hamilton. It is not known if Mary had siblings.
- 12. **Bridget CAREW** (Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born about 27 Aug 1869 in Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. She was christened on 27 Aug 1869 in Solohead, Co. Tipperary. She died in 1941 at the age of 72 in proabably Co. Tipperary. Sponsors at Bridget's baptism were John Ryan and Johanna Ryan. Bridget CAREW and John O'DWYER were married.

John O'DWYER was born about 1854 in Co. Limerick. He died in 1937 at the age of 83 in probably Co. Tipperary.

John O'DWYER and Bridget CAREW had the following child:

14. **Mary Ann CAREY** (Edmond-3, Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born in 1887 in Alexandria, New South Wales. She died in 1970 at the age of 83 in Sydney. Mary Ann CAREY and James F. REILLY were married.

James F. REILLY was born in 1886. He died in 1944 at the age of 58 in New South Wales.

James F. REILLY and Mary Ann CAREY had the following children:

- i **James Edmond REILLY**, born 1913, Waverley, New South Wales; married Anne MACDONALD; died 1943, Waverley, New South Wales.
- ii **Living** was born (date unknown).
- 47 iii **Living** was born (date unknown).
- 15. **Elizabeth (Liz) Ellen CAREY** (Edmond-3, Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born in 1889 in Sydney. She died in 1963 at the age of 74. Elizabeth (Liz) Ellen CAREY and Joseph Patrick MCCARTHY/KELLY were married in 1921 in Sydney.

Joseph Patrick MCCARTHY/KELLY was born in 1897.

Joseph Patrick MCCARTHY/KELLY and Elizabeth (Liz) Ellen CAREY had the following children:

- i **Marie Elizabeth KELLY/MCCARTHY**, born 1923, Clovelly, New South Wales; married David John ROSSITER; died 2008, Coffs Harbour, New South Wales.

23. Thomas Joseph TREACY (Mary Carey-3, Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born on 13 Apr 1881 in Murgasty, Co. Tipperary. He was christened about 13 Apr 1881 in Tipperary. He died on 13 Apr 1969 at the age of 88 in Carrick-on-Suir, Co. Tipperary. Thomas died on his 88th birthday. Thomas was buried in New Cemetery, Carrick-on-Suir, Co. Tipperary. The sponsors at Thomas's baptism was Sarah Carew, probably his aunt. There was no other sponsor listed on the baptism record.

Thomas began his career working at the gasworks in Tipperary town; according to the 1911 census he was a "gas account collector". On 28 September 1914 he took over the management of the gasworks in Carrick-on-Suir (located on the Quay), eventually buying the Carrick gasworks from the owner, Mr. Anderson. I am unsure as to the year of

purchase but it would probably have been during the mid- or late 1930s as it is known that Mr. Anderson still owned the Carrick gasworks in 1933.

Difficulties in getting parts from England for gasworks repairs during World War II led to problems in manufacturing gas at the Carrick works so Thomas decided to switch to the making of charcoal and in 1942 the large gasometers were dismantled. The business eventually concentrated on the sales of coal, coke and briquettes, and subsequently incorporated sales of gas stoves and heaters. Thomas Joseph TREACY and Ellen O'SULLIVAN were married on 12 Jan 1915 in Church of S.S. Peter And Paul, Cork. Witnesses to Ellen and Thomas' marriage were "M. J. Treacy" (Thomas' brother, Martin?) and "Julia O'Sullivan" (Ellen's sister?).



Ellen O'SULLIVAN, daughter of James (Big Jim) SULLIVAN and Julia DOODY, was born on 24 Oct 1887 in Glynn, Mourneabbey, Co. Cork. She was christened on 25 Oct 1887 in Analeentha Church, Mourneabbey, Co. Cork. She died on 18 Sep 1972 at the age of 84 in Carrick-on-Suir, Co. Tipperary. Ellen was buried in New Cemetery, Carrick-on-Suir.

According to Ellen's birth record, present at her birth was Mary O'Sullivan (probably her father's sister).

According to information from the Mallow Heritage Centre, the sponsors at Ellen's baptism were Cornelius Sweeney and Julia Curtin. It is believed Cornelius Sweeney was a neighbour of the Sullivans and it is thought he was married to one of Caheraveelane

Sullivans who were related to Ellen. A granddaughter of Cornelius would later marry Ellen's brother Denis. Julia Curtin, the second sponsor, had been a neighbour of the Sullivans when they lived in Ballyknockane. Julia would later marry Sean O'Looney; they emigrated to the United States and had 12 children. Valuable information on the Sullivan family, for which I am so grateful, came in November 2003 from 96-year-old Patrick, known as Pats, Curtin, a nephew of Julia's who lived in Ballyknockane with one of his daughters. Sadly, Pats died in September 2004.

It is thought that Ellen, who was also known as Nellie, had some domestic training and subsequently became a parlour maid. I am told that she met her husband, Thomas Treacy, in Tipperary town where they were both working (Thomas worked at the gasworks in the town). Based on this information I believe I have located a 1911 census record for Ellen. An Ellen Sullivan, aged 24 (although our Ellen was actually 23 years of age at the time of the census) and born in Co. Cork, was working as a parlour maid at the home of law agent George Hugh Chetwood Townsend in Cordangan, just a couple of miles south of Tipperary town. It was a large house and, along with Ellen, six other servants are listed.

However, according to Ellen's marriage record, her residence at the time (January 1915) was Lavitt's Quay, Cork

but it is not known how she came to move to Cork after apparently having met Thomas. She did have an uncle, Mike Doody, who was living at 5 Lavitt's Quay at the time of the 1911 census, while his wife, Mary Anne, was running a hotel at no 6. Perhaps Ellen was working at the hotel. Or perhaps, being from Co. Cork, Ellen wished to be married in Cork and therefore used her uncle's address to fulfil a possible residency requirement.

It is thought Ellen may have been related to a Hewitt family which included Patrick (1897-1979), a Holy Ghost priest who did missionary work in Tanganyika (now part of Tanzania), his brother James (1900-1974), a Holy Ghost brother who worked at Blackrock College in Dublin as a ground staff supervisor, and their sister Biddy who married a J.J. Healy and lived in Carrick-on-Suir. Other relatives of Ellen - or her husband, Thomas - included a couple who lived near Flamborough Head in Yorkshire in the 1940s. All we know of this couple is that the husband was in the Merchant Navy. Could they have been Ellen's aunt Hannah (O'Sullivan) and her husband Harry Williams, who was in the Merchant Navy? Further information would be most welcome.

According to a newspaper death notice, Ellen died in St. Brigid's Hospital, Carrick-on-Suir.

Thomas Joseph TREACY and Ellen O'SULLIVAN had the following children:

i **Patrick TREACY** was born between 1915 and 1920 in Waterford. He died between 1915 and 1920 at the age of 0 in Waterford. Patrick died as an infant. I am told he was born and died in a nursing home in Waterford city. However, I can find no trace of a birth or death record for him (in both Carrick-on-Suir and Waterford registration districts).

Note: It is surprising Patrick was not named Thomas as it was traditional at the time to name the eldest son after his paternal grandfather. Searches have been carried out for birth and death records for a Thomas Treacy, just in case (in both Carrick-on-Suir and Waterford registration districts), but nothing was found.

52 ii Mary Frances (Joan) TREACY was born on 20 Aug 1920 in Carrick-on-Suir, Co. Tipperary.



She died on 23 Oct 2003 at the age of 83 in Haywards Heath, West Sussex. She was buried in Shanganagh Cemetery, Dublin. The name on Joan's birth certificate is Mary Frances and on her baptism certificate it is Mary Bridget. However, she was called Joan by her family, although her nursing records are in the name of Mary Frances. She used the name is name for most of her life until after her retirement when she changed it to Jo-Ann.

Jo-Ann trained as a nurse in Manchester, qualifying in 1944. She had always wanted to travel so, following a number of years of general and industrial nursing in the UK, she joined the QARANC (Queen

Alexandra's Royal Army Nursing Corps) in 1952. Her first foreign posting was to Benghazi in Libya in 1953, followed by Cyprus in 1954.

Jo-Ann returned to England in 1956 and, while working at Shorncliffe Military Hospital, decided she wanted to specialise in nurse training. She embarked on a two-year course in Hull University, obtaining a Diploma in Nurse Training and Education in 1959, after which she spent many years training student nurses overseas during postings to Germany, Hong Kong and Singapore. In 1963, while serving in Hong Kong, she was awarded an Associate Royal Red Cross (ARRC) medal for exceptional services in military nursing.

Following her permanent return to England in 1970 Jo-Ann continued to train nurses at the military hospitals in Tidworth, Colchester, Aldershot and Woolwich. She retired in 1975 as Director of Studies at Woolwich and as acting colonel. She lived briefly in Brighton following her retirement before settling in Henfield in West Sussex. Jo-Ann never married although it is believed that she was engaged in the 1950s, possibly to a military doctor. Sadly, the marriage never took place because apparently her fiancé was killed in a bomb explosion in Cyprus, about which we have no details.

Jo-Ann died in hospital in Haywards Heath, West Sussex.

24. **Martin Joseph TREACY** (Mary Carey-3, Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born on 16 Nov 1883 in Murgasty Cottages, Murgasty, Co. Tipperary. He died on 19 Jan 1977 at the age of 93 in Fermoy, Co. Cork. He was buried in Kilcrumper Old Cemetery, Fermoy, Co. Cork. Sponsors at Martin's baptism were Edmond Carew and Bridget Carew.

According to the 1901 census return for his mother's household in Murgasty, Co. Tipperary, Martin, aged 17, was a baker. By the time of the 1911 census he was a gasworks manager, living on The Quay, Carrick-on-Suir (presumably in the house that adjoined the gasworks on the Quay) with his widowed mother. In late 1914 Martin was promoted to manager of the gasworks in Wicklow and was replaced in Carrick by his elder brother Thomas.

We know from The Irish Times editions of 21 and 28 October 1916 that Martin saved a boy from drowning during his time in Wicklow: "Mr Martin Tracey (sic), gas manager, Wicklow, saved the life of a boy named Robert Culbert, Strand street, Wicklow... Mr. Tracey jumped in and brought him ashore in an unconscious condition."

It is known that Martin's brother Timmy was living in Wicklow in 1918, which makes me think that Timmy may have been living with Martin (and probably their mother) as the Treacy family appears to have had no other Wicklow connections (I have heard that Martin and Timmy did not get on). In 1919 Martin was transferred to Fermoy, Co. Cork as manager of the gasworks there. It appears he lived in Duntahane, Fermoy for the rest of his life. According to a newspaper death notice, he died in St. Patrick's Hospital in Fermoy.

Martin Joseph TREACY and Catherine FOGARTY were married on 17 Jun 1919 in Carrick-on-Suir, Co. Tipperary. Martin and Catherine's marriage certificate gives an address of Carrick-on-Suir for Catherine and Wicklow for Martin



Catherine FOGARTY, daughter of James FOGARTY, was born about 1885 in Portlaw, Co. Waterford. She died on 5 Jan 1964 at the age of 79 in Fermoy, Co. Cork. Catherine was matron of a workhouse or hospital (presumably in Fermoy).

Martin and Catherine, who lived in Duntahane, Fermoy, had no children.

They did help raise Catherine's sister's two children, Maureen (known as Bunty) O'Sullivan and her sister (whose name I do not know) after their father died in 1930 in a motor accident when they were children. It is believed Bunty lived with Catherine and Martin in the aftermath of her father's death.

25. **Archibald Augustus HAMS** (Catherine (Kate) Carew-3, Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born in 1885. He died in 1960 at the age of 75. Archibald Augustus HAMS and Elizabeth Maria MCINTYRE were married.

Elizabeth Maria MCINTYRE was born in 1888 in Sydney. She died in 1958 at the age of 70 in Arncliffe, New South Wales.

Archibald Augustus HAMS and Elizabeth Maria MCINTYRE had the following children:

32. **Edmond (Ned) CAREW** (Daniel-3, Mary Hanley-2, Timothy or Michael-1) was born on 2 Apr 1898 in Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. He died on 28 Jun 1974 at the age of 76 in Soloheadbeg, Co. Tipperary. He was buried in Solohead Churchyard, Co. Tipperary. In the 1901 census Ned is listed, aged three, with the family of his aunt Catherine Ryan in Gortanerrig, Soloheadbeg. Presumably he was visiting at the time. Catherine was probably a sister of Ned's mother, Mary Coffey.

Ned was a farmer and lived in Soloheadbeg all his life. A death notice was located in online newspaper (Sunday Independent) archives for an Edmond Carew of Soloheadbeg who died at his residence on 28 June 1974. I believe that this notice refers to our Ned above.

Note: Ned's surname was Carew, and his children were christened with the surname Carew, but it appears the family sometimes goes by the name of Carey. Edmond (Ned) CAREW and Catherine FAHEY were married on 9 Feb 1932 in Annacarty, Co. Tipperary.

Catherine FAHEY, daughter of William FAHEY and Catherine (Kate) DOHERTY, was born on 7 Jan 1900 in Crossayle, Cappawhite, Co. Tipperary.

John MOYNIHAN, son of John MOYNIHAN, was born about 1884 in possibly Gullane, Gneeveguilla, Co. Kerry. He died on 9 Jun 1943 at the age of 59 in Lewis Road, Killarney, Co. Kerry. We have John's place of birth from the ship manifest from the voyage he and his family made to the United States in 1927 (presumably to visit his wife Alice's brothers who lived in New York), which gives his birthplace as simply "Gullane". There are several Gullanes in Ireland but given the fact that John moved to Killarney, Co. Kerry at some point following his retirement, and that Moynihan is a very common south Kerry name, make me think John was from Gullane, Gneeveguilla, not far from Killarney.

John was an RIC (Royal Irish Constabulary) police inspector. We do not know where he and Alice met but his address at the time of his marriage (1914) was Rosbercon, New Ross, Co. Wexford, and at the time of the birth of his daughter, Harriet (1915), he appears to have been stationed in Ennistymon, Co. Clare. John had retired by he time he made the trip above to the U.S. as he is described as a pensioner on the ship manifest, which also gives the family's last permanent residence as Duncannon, Co. Wexford.

John MOYNIHAN and Alice Frances MONAHAN had the following child:

He died on 10 Aug 1942 at the age of 52 in the Bronx, New York City. There is an Ellis Island record for a Patrick: he arrived in New York on October 27, 1912, aged 22 having sailed on the 'Carmania' from Liverpool. His occupation is given as "telephone operator" and his contact name is given as Martin Monahan, his uncle, of 500 3rd Avenue, New York.

It is thought that Patrick went to the United States as an athlete, sponsored by a brewery in New York. According to his World War I registration card - every male of military age was required to fill one in - he was working as a bartender in 1917 in what looks like the "Opper Copper" at 320 Broadway in New York and lived at what appears to be 264 West 21st St. The card also tells us he was 5' 10" in height, of medium build, had grey eyes and brown hair.

The 1920 census tells us he and his family were living at 989 Amsterdam Avenue in New York (unfortunately his occupation on the census return is illegible). By the time of the 1930 census he and the family were living at 190 Pennyfield Avenue in the Bronx and Patrick was working as a detective in the police force.

Patrick died of cancer at the age of 52.

Patrick MONAHAN and Hanora (Nora) BURKE were married on 18 May 1914 in probably New York.

Hanora (Nora) BURKE was born about 1891 in Co. Galway. She died on 18 Aug 1959 at the age of 68 in New York City. A family member has recalled Nora "walking down the street with her beer pail in hand to obtain her brew". This would have been after Nora settled in New York.

Patrick MONAHAN and Hanora (Nora) BURKE had the following children:

On the ship manifest his occupation as given as "ship's steward", and his contact name was an uncle, Martin Monahan, who lived in New York. Sadly, Edward's father, Patrick, died only nine days after Edward's arrival in the States.

Edward's World War I registration card - every male of military age was required to complete one - tells us that Edward was working as a porter in 1917 in a hotel at 73rd St. and Broadway in New York. The name of the hotel is almost illegible but it could be the Ansonia. The card also tells us he lived at what looks like 206 8th Avenue in New York and that he was "tall", of medium build, had grey eyes and brown hair.

I believe I have found Edward in the 1920 and 1930 censuses. There is an Irish-born Edward Monahan of a similar age lodging in Manhattan in 1920 and working as a waiter. In 1930 an Edward Monahan, who emigrated from Ireland in 1915, is working as a houseman for an Epstein family in Yonkers, New York. This Edward, who was 36 years old, was married at the age of 29, but his wife is not listed as a member of the household. Taking the difference between his census age and his age at marriage we have an approximate year of marriage of 1923. Marriage records were located on the Ancestry website for two Edward Monahans who were married in New York around that time; one was married in Kings County (equivalent to Brooklyn) on 6 March 1923 and the other in Kings on 19 August 1925 but in neither case is the bride's name provided so we cannot say if either of these records relates to our Edward. It appears Edward and Mamie had no children.

Edward was only 42 years of age when he died. Edward MONAHAN and Mary (Mamie) RYAN were married.

Mary (Mamie) RYAN was born (date unknown).

According to the notes of his grandnephew Brent, Martin was born on April 15, 1901. However, according to the 1901 census, Martin was two years old on March 31, 1901. The ages given on the census return for the rest of the children (except for Harriet who wasn't yet born) tie in with the dates of birth provided by Brent.

Royal Irish Constabulary (RIC) records show that a Martin J. Monahan, who was born in 1898 in Co. Wexford, enlisted in the the force in 1920. This may be our Martin.

If it was our Martin who joined the RIC in 1920 then he did not stay very long as Ellis Island records show that our Martin arrived in New York on 22 May 1922, aged 23 and single, having sailed on the 'Adriatic' from Liverpool. According to the ship manifest, he was a labourer and was joining his brother Patrick who lived at 989 Amsterdam Avenue in New York. At the time of his first marriage in 1927 he was working as a chauffeur, and by the time of his second marriage in 1956 he was a "maintenance supervisor (bank offices)".

Note: There is a record in the Social Security Death Index for a Martin Monahan who was born on 25th February 1899. This has been checked out but it is NOT our Martin. Martin Joseph MONAHAN and Catherine (Kitty) HARNETT were married on 24 Apr 1927 in Church of the Immaculate Conception, The Bronx, New York City. Witnesses were Francis Moran and Bridget (Bridgie) Harnett. It is likely that Briddgie was Kitty's sister Bridget.



Catherine (Kitty) HARNETT, daughter of Michael HARNETT and Mary MCCARTHY, was born on 1 Jul 1903 in Dromtrasna O'Brien, Abbeyfeale, Co. Limerick. She died in PROBABLY EARLY 1950S in probably New York. We had been told that Kitty was from Abbeyfeale, Co. Limerick and that she had a brother who was a priest, possibly named Dan, and a sister named Hannie who married a Jack Sheehan. Hannie and Jack lived in Athea and had a family, including two daughters, Mary (c.1923-1993) who never married and Bridie (c.1930-2009) who married Jack Stackpoole. And from Kitty's marriage record we learned that her parents were Michael Harnett and Mary McCarthy.

It appears Kitty emigrated to the United States in 1923 as an immigration record has been located for a 20-year-old Catherine Harnett, daughter of Michael Harnett from Dromtrasna,

who arrived in Boston on 1 November 1923. Her destination city is given as Manchester, New Hampshire.

Kitty is named as a witness on her sister Helen's Petition for Naturalization, dated 13 April 1937. Kitty's address at this time was 559 W. 172nd St., Bronx, New York.

Martin met Kathleen on a visit to Ireland in 1955. It is believed they met in Duncannon, Co. Wexford. Kathleen, a widow, was from Ballyhack, Co. Wexford, not far from Duncannon, but was living in Liverpool (at 36 Porchester Road) at the time she met Martin. She and her first husband, Howard Kennedy, had a daughter, also named Kathleen who would have been about 21 years old at the time.

Martin returned to the U.S. after his trip and travelled to Liverpool a year later to marry Kathleen. After the marriage Kathleen and her daughter moved to New York. Martin and Kathleen later separated.


